

## Kindergarten Supply List

Dear WBCS Kindergarten Families,

It is important that each child has a backpack to carry his/her take home folder. This folder should go to school each morning and will go home every night. In this folder you will find important paperwork from your child's teacher as well as your child's hard work!



In your child's backpack, please leave an extra change of clothes in case of accidents or spills. It is a big help to the teachers and your child! Please label this bag with your child's name!

If possible, please also include an art smock or an old, large, shirt that will assist our Art teacher with keeping the students' uniforms clean. Please label this with your child's name.

### Kindergarten classroom supplies:

- 1 plastic folder labeled with your child's name
- Labeled change of clothes to keep in your child's cubby
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair of child school scissors (blunt tip)
- 2 boxes (24 count) of crayons
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 packs of black dry erase markers
- 2 pink erasers
- 1 package of pencils
- 1 package of baby wipes
- 1 pair of headphones (please no ear buds)
- 1 box ziploc bags (any size)
- Labeled art smock or old t-shirt
- One pencil case or bag to keep supplies in.
- Plastic pencil box
- Clothing to go outside daily in all weather (Boots, warm pants/snow pants, hats/gloves, etc.)
- A reusable water bottle for personal use (labeled)



In addition to the above supplies, your child will be required to wear a clean face mask when traveling through hallways, on the school bus, and when social distancing of 6 feet can not be maintained. Please speak with your child about the importance of face coverings and have your child practice wearing a mask before his/her return to school.

Curriculum Extension- Art, Music, Physical Education, and Technology Supplies:

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 glue sticks
